On November 2, 2007, the following met with Rudy Brioché, Legal Advisor to Commissioner Jonathan Adelstein: Daniel Brenner, Senior Vice President, Law and Regulatory Policy (NCTA), Diane Burstein, Vice President and Deputy General Counsel (NCTA), Lauren Van Wazer, Chief Policy and Technology Counsel (Cox Enterprises); Andrew Jay Schwartzman (Media Access Project); Harold Feld (Media Access Project); and Parul Desai (Media Access Project). During our meeting, we discussed the issues raised in Comments that were filed in this proceeding.

We exchanged ideas on possible ways to reform the leased access process, including using the FCC's website to assist prospective lessees in better understanding how to contact cable systems to lease time. Additionally, we exchanged ideas on possible ways to reform the complaint process. We also exchanged views regarding whether other options were available with respect to signal distribution. Finally, we exchanged views on the need for recognition of "opportunity cost" in the leased access formula.
